### **AQUAVITUS**

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Why did the world's biggest producer of aquavit pull the plug on B.C., leaving thousands of Danes; and other lovers of curried herring and duck with red cabbage and rémoulade; high and dry? Whatever the reason, in steps Frank Deiter and his multiple-award-winning Okanagan Spirits operation, and after a brief time tweaking and tasting and distilling, out comes Aquavit. Rich and hearty with essence of caraway, more velvety than the boring Aalborg we used to buy, sharp and spicy but not burning and certainly not oily; this is world-class aquavit. Not in liquor stores yet, so the distillery in Vernon is the single source for now. Well priced, too, at \$29.95. Skoal, then, eh?
